

For the past eight years, Priceless has built a community of volunteers, mentors, donors, and partner organizations united in declaring against human and sex trafficking, “NOT ON ALASKAN SOIL.” In those eight years, stories that were once rooted in the crime and trauma of sex trafficking and slavery have been rewritten as stories of freedom, hope, and healing.

THE NEED

Today’s COVID environment has ***ongoing ramifications to our non-profit donor base and funds.*** Long-term operations are in need of new donors and supporters to continue the work of Priceless.

Our current survivors in the Priceless program are experiencing more roadblocks to success than ever due to current COVID and economic conditions. From lack of housing, finding employers who will hire someone with a criminal background, and shortage of hourly wage paying jobs, these women are fighting hard to claim new lives for themselves and their children. Add onto this the existing trauma of a trafficking background and recovery from addictions for many, the roadblocks seem insurmountable.

Further, ***new survivors are identified and referred to Priceless weekly*** by law enforcement partners, shelters, and even other Priceless clients.

THE OPPORTUNITY

On November 1, Priceless will launch a holiday fundraising campaign in the form of an online story catalogue. We will tell the stories of brave survivors who can testify to the reality of hope and healing. We will share the stories of mentors who’ve walked with broken people into vibrant, self-sustaining lives. ***And we will celebrate a holiday season of the ultimate gift: FREEDOM.***

Our hope for this campaign is to:

- Share freedom stories with those currently being trafficking in hopes they will reach out for help.
- Bring fresh awareness and education around the issue of trafficking in Alaska.
- Stir up Alaskans to join the work of Priceless through support, volunteerism, and mentorship.

In the shadow of my chaotic childhood with lots of sexual abuse and drug abuse, I continued this behavior as an adult. I became involved in selling drugs; and though I never thought of myself as someone who would sell my body, I fell into it unintentionally. One day a girl, who I thought was my friend, took me to a house, and I immediately knew I was in trouble when I got there. That was the beginning of my trafficking story...

Eventually law enforcement got involved. From there I became involved with the Priceless organization—they have helped me in countless ways. But the person who has been key in my transformation is my mentor. She was the first person to really believe in me no matter what. She is truly a gift from God. I hope that I will be able to help other girls who have been trafficked. That somehow telling my story will illuminate the good news about God and how He saves and brings peace.

At the end, I was a broken, empty shell that was utterly exhausted. I coped by being constantly high on meth, weed, and alcohol. When I went to jail the last time, I knew I needed to get out. I connected with Priceless inside the jail, and they were waiting for me when I was released...

What I gained were two individuals who scared me to death with the goodness of their hearts. They saved my life. We started off simple with once-a-week coffee dates and talking. Somewhere in me, I had always dreamed to be just like them. These two women saved my life by taking the time and patience to understand me and offer complete love...

I hope to be a walking testimony to those who may benefit from my growth and be the best I can be for myself and my family.

The first time I found myself in a trafficking situation was when I was about 16 years old. The men I surrounded myself with were way older and got me addicted to drugs. It was at that time I started doing whatever I needed to stay high and drown out my pain...

I spent eight months in an inpatient treatment facility, and when I was finished, I knew I would never go back to the life I was living before...

I am purchasing my childhood home, where I get to create new, beautiful, and sober memories for my babies. When I think about what I want in the future, I just want true happiness and peace. I want to be the mother to my children that I needed when I was little.
